National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES)

went into effect on November 1, 2011,

despite strong political opposition. The NPDES will affect how mosquito control personnel apply adulticides and larvicides, including the use of biological larvicides. The Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has prepared updated Flow Charts, NPDES General Permit information and a Fact Sheet on their website:

Most mosquito control operations are still exempt under the updated Nebraska DEQ provisions. However, NMVCA recommends following this updated flow chart to determine if your operation is exempt. All mosquito control groups should develop a Best Management Practice Plan as described in the Flow Chart tables.

2012 Grant Recipients

The NMVCA awarded two \$500 grants in May, 2012. Grant funds were to be used to assist mosquito control agencies or communities in conducting mosquito control operations. Grants were specifically to be used for equipment, chemical or surveillance purchases. The NMVCA had many quality applications. The 2012 grant recipients:
